



MEMBER CODE OF CONDUCT



The Code of Conduct has been developed to ensure a safe, friendly and respectful place for members and guests to gather in the spirit of cooperation, relaxation, good will, fun and friendly competition.

The code of conduct differs from rules in that it addresses acceptable / unacceptable behaviour.

All members and guests of the Fairfield Golfers Club (FGC) are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that:

- Creates an environment and culture that is reflective of the personal integrity and respect taught in the rules of golf where it is written that we are capable of enforcing rules upon ourselves with honesty, integrity and good sportsmanship. This same integrity, honesty and goodwill are expected whether on the golf course itself or anywhere else on the golf course property.
- Is free of discrimination or any form of harassing behaviour including sexual harassment.
- Acknowledges FGC as a family friendly environment and, therefore, refrains from using obscenities and loud boisterous behaviour where and when it is inappropriate.
- Observes proper etiquette on the course and anywhere else on the course property.
- Shows the utmost respect and dignity to fellow members, course staff and guests.
- Is reflective of an adherence to ALL Local Golf Club rules and procedures including but not limited to:
 - Sign in procedures in the course pro shop.
 - Compliance with guidelines, local rules and daily special instructions regarding the rental, safe operation and on-course use of power carts, including adherence to directives outlining areas where usage is prohibited.
 - Use and proper care of putting greens.
- Demonstrates an understanding that FGC members and guests have no authority to instruct course staff in their job performance and duties
- Understand that Course management is solely responsible for instructing their staff in the performance of their duties.



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- Is vigilant in reporting real or perceived safety hazards to fellow FGC members and golf course staff.
- Agrees to adhere to all FGC rules and policies, including the consumption of alcohol, not purchased from the Golf Course, on golf course property.
- Understands the accepted methods whereby FGC members may make suggestions to the club's Board of Directors regarding the operation of the club for the betterment of the club.
- Does not create unnecessary strife and divisiveness in any manner.
- Does not misrepresent their position and/or authority to any others.
- Follows guidelines for proper attire of players as per the respective Golf Course Dress Code Policy.

Any member of FGC found to be in violation of this Code of Conduct may be suspended or expelled from the club for unseemly conduct upon a vote of the majority of the Board of Directors in a meeting duly called for such purpose. Such member shall be entitled to prior written or verbal warning of the particulars of his conduct.

Any guests of FGC, on the golf course, or anywhere on the course's property, found to be in violation of this Code of Conduct may be subject to restrictions regarding further attendance at FGC events.
